The Board of Education believes that the goals and objectives of this district are best achieved by a diversity of learning experiences, some of which are more appropriately conducted outside the regular instructional program of the school. The purpose of such co-curricular activities shall be to develop leadership capacities and good organizational skills, to aid in the socialization of pupils, and to enable pupils to explore a wider range of individual interests than might be available in the regular curricular program.

The Board of Education recognizes that participation in extra-curricular activities is a right which carries with it certain responsibilities including:

1. Maintaining satisfactory academic achievement.
2. Recognition that participants in extra-curricular activities represent the school and the community and should project positive images of both.
3. Maintaining standards of conduct during school attendance as outlined in the discipline policy and individual written rules for each activity or sport.

Students participating in clubs and activities are expected to adhere to all school policies, the school Code of Conduct, and maintain satisfactory academic achievement. The following information is provided regarding participation in Alpha Public School Clubs and Activities:

- Students must maintain a “C” or better average in all classes to remain eligible to participate in Clubs and Activities.
- Students who have a “D” average in any class will be able to participate during a probationary period. This will include a contract developed with goals and timelines for improving grade to at least a “C” average.
- Students who have an “F” average in any class will be removed from all Clubs and Activities. The student can apply for reinstatement.
- Students must maintain satisfactory attendance including limited unexcused absences and tardiness to school at the discretion of the Principal. Notification of probation or removal with regards to attendance issues will be addressed by Mr. Seth Cohen.
